3. Tongues is a direct line to talking to God (1 Corinthians 14:2).
4. Tongues gives us direct access to the throne room of God (1 Corinthians 14:2).
5. Tongues is speaking divine mysteries and secrets (1 Corinthians 14:2).
6. Tongues draws out secrets concerning life's complicated issues (1 Corinthians 14:2).
7. Tongues is prophesying our God-ordained future (1 Corinthians 2:7, 9).
8. Tongues is praying out God's plan for our lives (1 Corinthians 2:7, 9).
9. Tongues are knowledge, counsel, and secrets pertaining to you that are held from the wicked one (1 Corinthians 14:2).
10. Tongues is strengthening our inner man with might (Ephesians 3:16).
11. Tongues keeps us spiritually fit (1 Corinthians 14:4).
12. Tongues is praying things concealed to be revealed (1 Corinthians 14:2).
13. Tongues pulls us from the past into our future (1 Corinthians 2:7, 9).
14. Tongues is our source of spiritual edification (1 Corinthians 14:4).
15. Tongues will build a strong premise to carry the anointing of God (Acts 2:4).
16. Tongues builds and stimulates our faith (Jude 20).
17. Tongues will give us unstoppable progress that our enemies cannot deny (1 Corinthians 2:7, 9)
18. Tongues is giving praise and thanksgiving unto God (1 Corinthians 14:16-17).
19. Tongues lines us up with the divine will of God (Romans 8:27).

29. Tongues fine-tunes and sensitizes our spirit man to the voice of God (Acts 2:4, 11).
30. Tongues brings our natural tongue under subjection (Acts 2:4-11; 9:17, 20-22; 10:44-46)
31. Tongues develops intimacy with the Holy Ghost (Acts 2:1-4; 2 Corinthians 13:14).

32. Tongues is our private conversation with God (1 Corinthians 14:2).
33. Tongues is deep calling unto deep (1 Corinthians 2:10).
34. Tongues accesses revelation knowledge (1 Corinthians 2:7, 10).
35. Tongues taps into the mind of God (1 Corinthians 2:16).
36. Tongues opens the scriptures to us from a divine perspective rather than an intellectual one (1 Corinthians 2:12-13).

47. Tongues is blowing the ram's horn for battle (Joshua 6:8, 20).
48. Tongues releases angels on heavenly assignments to change earthly situations (Acts 12:3-8).
49. Tongues helps us tap into the creativity of Elohim (God the Creator) (Ephesians 2:10).

51. Tongues reverses demonic assignments against our wellbeing (Acts 12:1-8).
52. Tongues removes us from the limitations of the flesh, to God's abundant supply of the Spirit (Galatians 5:16-25; Philippians 1:19).
53. Tongues makes demands on the power of God (Acts 1:8).
54. Tongues enables us to have a closer walk with God (John 14:16, 26; Acts 2:38-39).
55. Tongues is speaking the hidden wisdom of God (1 Corinthians 2:5-7).
56. Tongues is the beginning and key to being led by the Spirit (Romans 8:14).
57. Tongues is living supernaturally in a natural world (Acts 2:1-17).
58. Tongues opens the heavens and charges the atmosphere (Acts 2:1-4).
59. Tongues is the release of the Shekinah glory of God (Acts 2:1-17).

65. Tongues causes the wind of God to blow in our lives (Acts 2:1-4).
66. Tongues releases revival in our lives (Acts 2:1-18; Acts 19:1-6).
67. Tongues is the key to refilling empty vessels (Acts 2:4).
68. Tongues is our human spirits communicating to God's Spirit (1 Corinthians 14:2, 14-15).
69. Tongues is being endued with power from on high (Luke 24:49).
70. Tongues is building the image of God in you and with confidence (Jude 20; Romans 8:26-29).
71. Tongues is declaring the will of God in the earth (Romans 8:26-27).
